- G. North Carolina Preparedness Month Proclamation - Bobby Arledge, Emergency Management Director

Commissioner Moore moved to approve the proclamation and declare September 2024 as Preparedness Month, seconded by Vice-Chairman Melton and the motion carried unanimously.

- H. North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Agreement to Assume Responsibility of Wolverine Trail and Budget Amendment to bring up to NCDOT Standards - Manager Pittman.

Manager Pittman presented the agreement between Polk County and NCDOT for NCDOT to bring Wolverine Trail up to state standards. He said Wolverine Trail is currently a private road, and this is the last step to making it a state-maintained public road.

Commissioner Beiler moved to approve the Agreement Overview between NCDOT and Polk County and to approve the budget amendment in the amount of \$75,000, seconded by Vice-Chairman Melton and the motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Moore moved to approve the Secondary Road Right of Way Agreement for Wolverine Trail, seconded by Vice-Chairman Melton and the motion carried unanimously.
